

Idaho ABE CASAS Training Requirements

Who:

All ESL personnel who administer the CASAS

What:

Regional CASAS Administrator Trainer- face-to-face & mentored

6 hour face-to-face training offered in June each year. An additional 14 hours of mentored practice. (see Idaho Assessment Policy: CASAS Administrator and Scorer Certification Training)

20 hours

6 hrs. face-to-face

8 hrs. CASAS administration in own region

2 hrs. of report on own administration linked to guidelines

3 hrs. observation of main site CASAS administration,

1 hrs. report on status of main site CASAS administration

New CASAS administrators- face-to-face

Training by a state approved CASAS trainer [see Idaho Assessment Policy: Pre-service CASAS Test Administrators Training

8 hours

4 hours observation of CASAS administration

4 hrs. administering CASAS with observation of regional trainer

Experienced CASAS administrators- face-to-face

Training by a state approved CASAS trainer [see Idaho Assessment Policy: In-service CASAS Administrators Training

4 hours

3 hrs. observation of administrator by regional trainer

1 hr. review of observation

When & Where:

Regional Trainers: Check with state office/CASAS State Trainer (State office – 208. 334.3216, ask for ABE director)

Local Staff: Check with regional PD Specialists and Program Director.
