

Idaho ABE TABE Training Requirements

Who:

All ABE personnel who administer the TABE

What:

Regional TABE Administrator Trainer- face-to-face & mentored

6 hour face-to-face training offered in June each year. An additional 14 hours of mentored practice. (see Idaho Assessment Policy: TABE Administrator and Scorer Certification Training)

20 hours

6 hrs. June face-to-face

8 hrs. TABE administration in own region

2 hrs. of report on own administration linked to guidelines

3 hrs. observation of main site TABE administration,

1 hrs. report on status of main site TABE administration

New TABE administrators- face-to-face

Training by a state approved TABE trainer (see Idaho Assessment Policy: Pre-service TABE Test Administrators Training)

8 hours

4 hours observation of complete battery administration

4 hrs. administering TABE with observation of regional trainer

Experienced TABE administrators- face-to-face

Training by a state approved TABE trainer (see Idaho Assessment Policy: In-service TABE Administrators Training –Previously trained test administrators)

4 hours

3 hrs. observation of administrator by regional trainer

1 hr. review of observation

When & Where:

Regional Trainers: Check with state office/TABE State Trainer (State office – 208. 334.3216, ask for ABE director)

Local Staff: Check with regional PD Specialists and Program Director.
