Degree Based Career Techncial Certificate

- Completion of approved educator preparation program
- University recommendation for certificate/ endorsement including:
- > 1,000 clock hours of related work experience or a practicum
- Positive student teaching experience
- Passing score on board-approved related content-area assessment
- Cleared background check and signed legal history questionnaire
- Certificate valid for five years; renewable
- Degree Based Career Technical Certification discipline areas:
- Agricultural Science and Technology
- Business Technology Education
- Computer Science Technology
- → Engineering
- Family and Consumer Sciences
- Marketing Technology Education
- Technology Education



Industry Professional to CTE Teacher

(Secondary and Postecondary)

Limited Occupational Specialist (LOS)

- Hold minimum of high school diploma or
- Document one of the following to earn
- > Baccalaureate degree in endorsementrelated area and 2,000 endorsementrelated industry hours with one-half of hours acquired during recent five years
- 6,000 endorsement-related industry hours with one-half of hours acquired during recent five years
- Industry certification, as approved by IDCTE, in endorsement area
- Document industry experience to meet the majority of endorsement focus areas to earn endorsement
- , Must qualify for both certificate and endorsement
- Meet requirements of occupationally related state agencies
- Certificate is valid for three years; not
- May teach while completing requirements noted under next column to achieve SOS Certificate

Standard Occupational Specialist (SOS)

- Completed requirements of LOS Certificate, as follows:
- Complete First Camp and First Camp OA • Complete one of the two following options:
- 1. University coursework
- Tuition and other expenses are the responsibility of the teaching candidate

- Must be employed as teacher by school district or higher education institution
- InSpIRE Ready! specifics:

- IDCTE Secondary Practice

- Certificate valid for five years; renewable

Advanced Occupational Specialist (AOS)

- additional credits of education or contentarea transcripted coursework
- Certificate valid for five years; renewable

- Available to individuals eligible for the SOS Certificate

• Complete teacher training degree or 18

- successful mentoring

Current Teacher to CTE Teacher

CTE Alternative Teacher to New Secondary

- Hold valid and current renewable Idaho **Educator Certificate**
- Hold baccalaureate degree
- Employed by a school district
- District Submits CTEAA TN application
- Interim certificate valid for one to three years depending on route
- Routes:
- Participate in approved route preparation program
- Hold Masters in endorsement area;
- > Successful Praxis® in endorsement area; successful mentoring; coursework in Principles and Foundations of CTE; training in CTSO leadership and occupational analysis; AND 200-hour industry externship in endorsement area sought

Three Other Routes to CTE Teacher

CTE Alternative Authorization Content Specialist (CTEAA - CS) Secondary

CTE Public Charter Teacher

- Employed by a school district
- Hold minimum of baccalaureate degree
- District submits CTEAA CS application
- Demonstrate content knowledge through one of the following:
- Baccalaureate degree in subject area to be taught
- Passing score on board-approved related content area assessment
- Passing score on State Board of Education's Uniform Standard for **Evaluating Content Competency**
- Complete board-approved alternate route to authorization
- Interim certificate valid for three years

• Refer to the requirements for Limited Occupational Specialist (LOS) route

Individual Filling a CTE Educator Position for One Year (Provisional)

- Awarded only with formal approval by State Board of Education
- Must:
- Hold associate degree or demonstrate 48 semester college credits on official transcript
- Provide evidence of declaration of emergency need by the school district
- Certificate is valid for one year
