Part 2: Completed by high school of previous enrollment (not applicable if homeschooled)

Pursuant to IDAPA 08.02.01.650.02, the State Board of Education mandates that GED applicants ages 16 and 17 must submit to the GED testing center written verification of withdrawal from the last school attended, unless homeschooled and meet one of the following criteria before GED testing. Check as applicable:

- Behind one year or more in credits earned
- Expelled, or on recommendation of the school
- Pregnant or a parent
- Entering college, military service, or an employment training program
- Enrolled in an adult education or Job Corps program
- Incarcerated

Students do not need proof of enrollment in college, military service, employment training, adult education, or job corps.

A person must be at least 16 years of age and not currently enrolled in an accredited high school, either full or part-time, in order to qualify to take the GED in Idaho. Testers ages 16 and 17 must complete the Youth Waiver Request Form and present it to their local GED testing center before scheduling the GED test. Questions regarding scheduling or taking your GED tests should be directed to your local GED testing center or GED Testing Services on GED.com.

Youth Waiver Request Form Instructions

Step 1

Set up a free account at GED.com before completing the GED Youth Waiver Request. Keep the email address and password you used when creating this account in a secure location. Access your GED.com account to find a testing center, schedule tests, view test scores, and find answers to questions about GED testing.

Step 2

Homeschooled students: Only complete Parts 1 and 3 of the Youth Waiver Request Form. Students participating in the Idaho Digital Learning Academy or other online, home-based schools are NOT considered homeschooled for the purpose of this form.

- Part 1 of the form specifies the student is homeschooled. This information is only used by the testing center and is not collected or tracked by the State of Idaho or the Department of Education. Checking this box, when appropriate, helps the testing center process your GED test request more efficiently.
- Part 3 must be signed by both the student and the student's parent or guardian.

All other students: Students previously enrolled in a public or private high school or who participated in the Idaho Digital Learning Academy or another online, home-based school must complete Parts 2 and 3 of this form.

Pursuant to Idaho code 650.01, Part 2 of the form confirms that the student is no longer enrolled in high school and indicates the school has met with the student and a parent or legal guardian to discuss GED testing options. The GED Youth Waiver Request must be completed and signed by a counselor or principal at the school where the student was previously enrolled.

Part 3 must be signed by both the student and the student's parent or guardian. Incarcerated, adjudicated, emancipated, and/or married youth are not required to provide a parent/guardian signature. Verified digital signatures are accepted. Otherwise, please print and sign the form before emailing it to your testing center.

Step 3

Email, mail, or take this completed form to the local testing center where the student wishes to complete GED testing. To locate a testing center near you, go to GED.com Your chosen testing center will authorize the student to begin scheduling tests once they have received and validated the completed release form.
