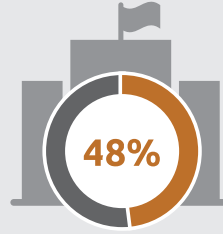
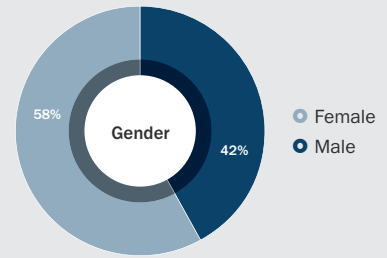


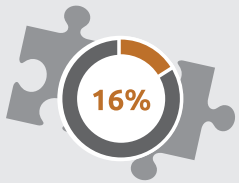
Adult Education

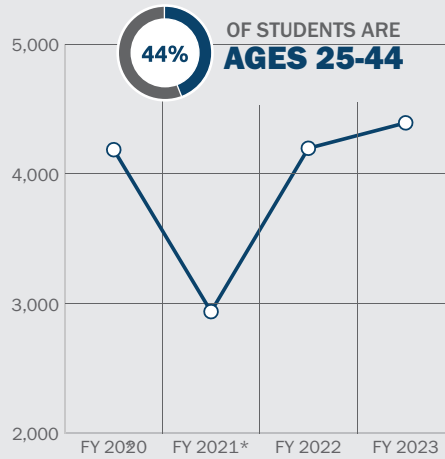
OF IELCE* STUDENTS ATTAINED A POSTSECONDARY CREDENTIAL

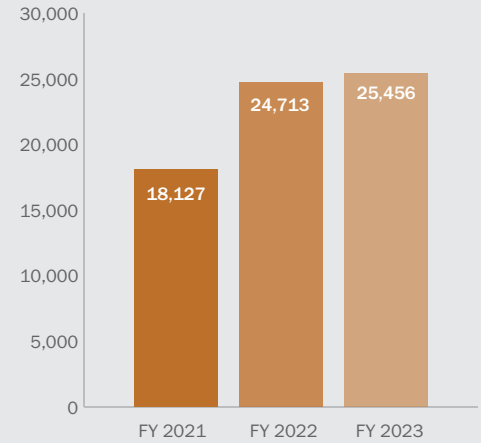

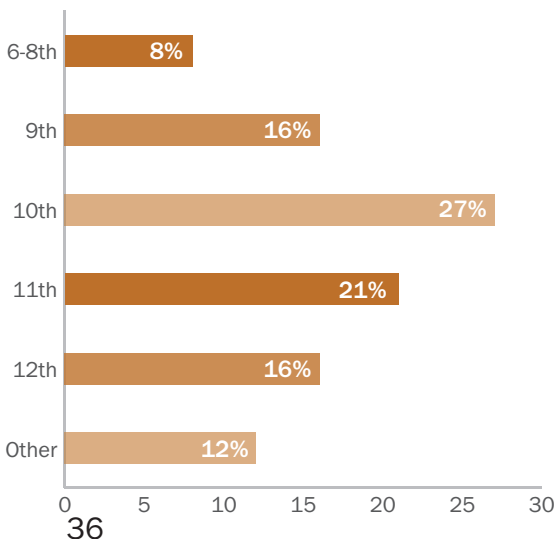

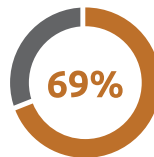
