SkillStack® Recruit is a free, robust database that allows employers like you to find employees with specific skills aligned with the jobs you're trying to fill. Once you've found qualified candidates, invite them to apply or learn more about your companyright from SkillStack[®].

Here's how to get started:

Register

- Go to skillstack.idaho.gov.
- In the upper right-hand corner of the page, click Register.
- From the pop-up window, click on the Employer button.
- Complete the required fields with your company's



information. Please note this information will be used to send recruiting emails.

- Click Submit. Your account will be pending approval until we verify ٠ your account. Watch for an email from skillstack@cte.idaho.gov.
- In the meantime, you can become familiar with microcredentials that fit your hiring needs by going to **Badges** in the upper left-hand corner.

Search



- In the upper right-hand corner, click Log in and enter your username and password.
- In the upper left-hand corner, click Recruit.
- To find candidates:
 - » First, use the checkboxes to choose which region(s) you want to search within.
 - » Use the search box to search for specific badges or select career fields by clicking on the box in the Selected column. Click on the triangles to narrow your search and identify individuals who have demonstrated specific skills.
 - » If you only want candidates with a particular badge, select one at a time. For a broader search, you can select multiple badges and anyone that has earned one of those badges will be selected.
- As you select badges, Unique Recipients will update to show the number of qualified candidates. You can refine your Unique Recipients by specifying the time frame when digital badges were earned.

Recruit

- Review the pre-populated email message.
 - » To update your contact information, click on Hello <YOUR USERNAME>! in the upper right-hand corner.
 - » Edit information as needed and click Update.
- Customize your message by clicking on the or + buttons to the left of the • message.
- Click on Send a Test Email to verify the content and format of the email (optional).
- When you're happy with the message, click Send Email.
- You can also track how many emails were sent over time and to how many ٠ candidates (Targets).
