SkillStack® Updates

- We get our data for SkillStack® from a longitudinal data system—ISEE (Idaho System for Educational Excellence)
- We get a data set from them in October, November, December, and March
- October & November rosters have been uploaded for CTE capstone courses
- Developer co-developed an API to help with the Workforce Readiness Assessment badges and the Technical Skills Assessment badges that is done by CTECS—a third party vendor for testing.
- Working on two sets of new badges:
 - o Digital Navigator Badges
 - o State Department of Education Math Badges

- Related policy: III.L Prior Learning
- Course Transfer
 - If a student has earned a set of badges (i.e. graphic design) they could go to <u>coursetransfer.idaho.gov</u> and see what courses they could opt out of because they've earned those badges.
 - So now that there is no TCC, this course transfer will help students see what badges equal credit rather than leaving them guessing.
 - Talking to transition coordinators to get this started.
