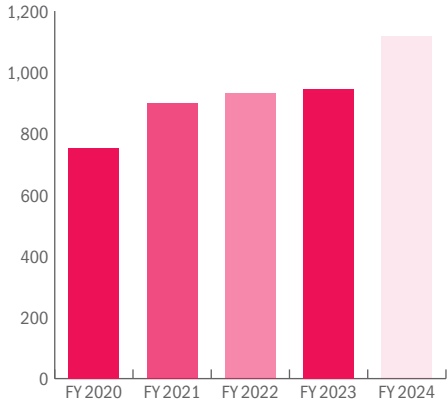

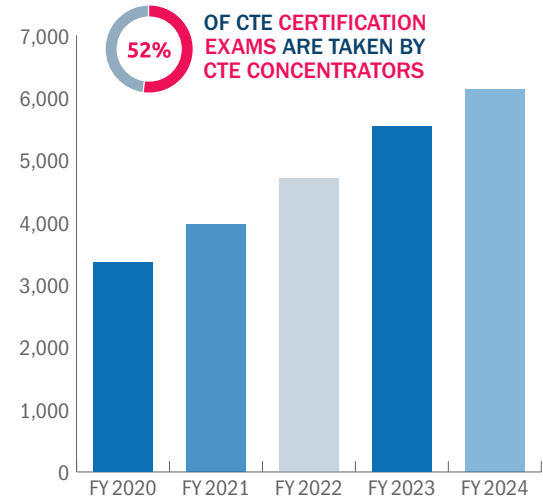

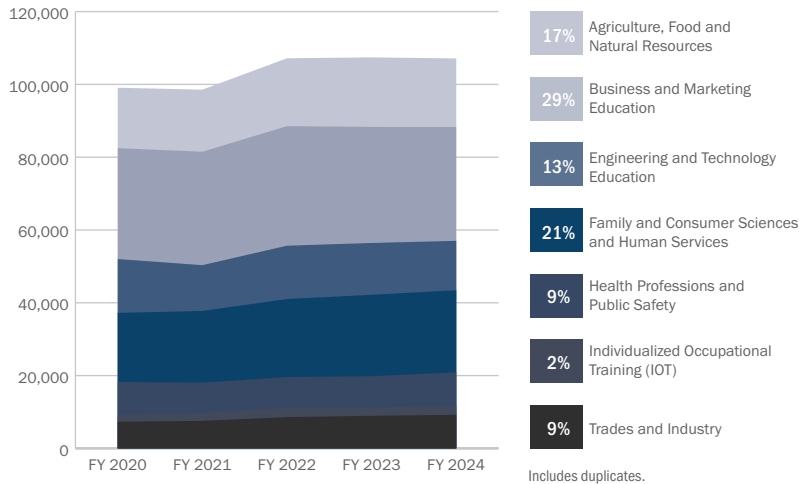

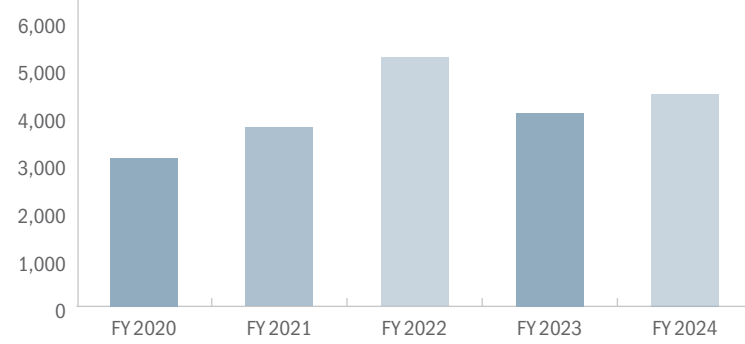
NUMBER OF CTE CERTIFICATION EXAMS TAKEN



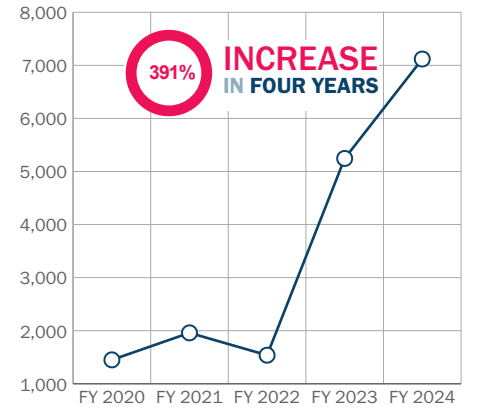

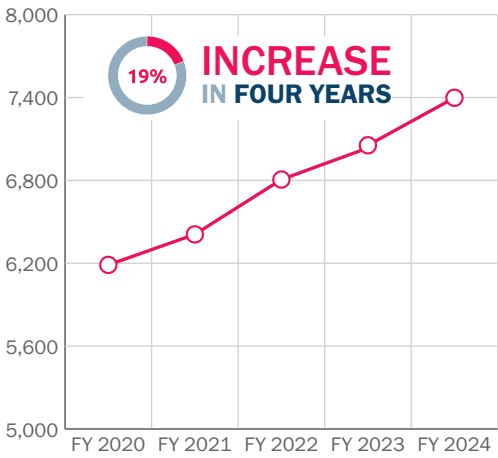

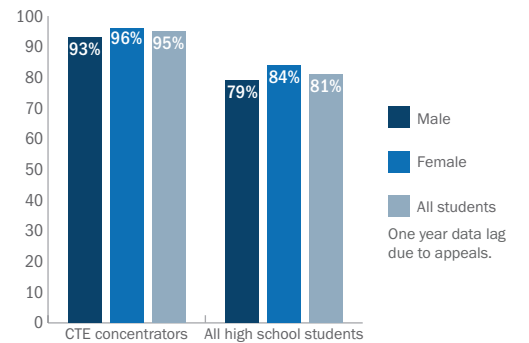

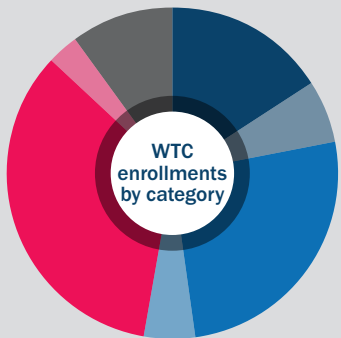

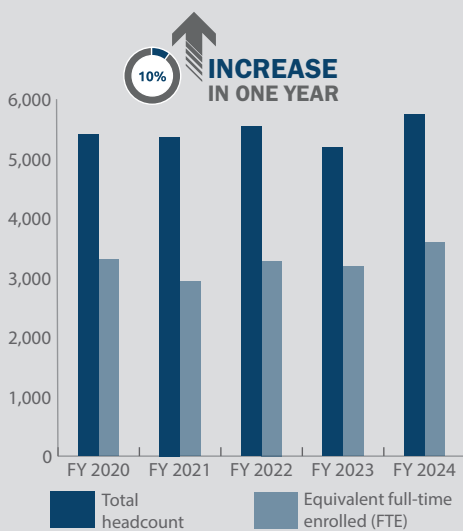

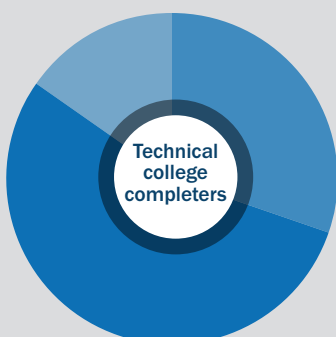

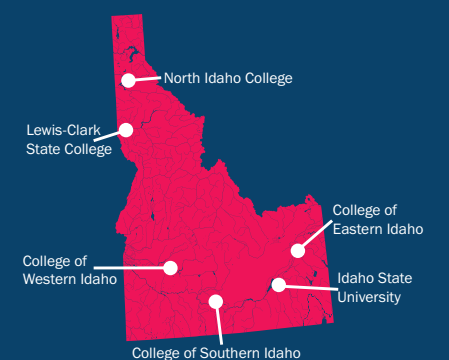
