

What is SkillStack®?

SkillStack® is a microcredential platform that allows Idaho educators to validate skills demonstrated by learners, resulting in industry-recognized digital badges. A digital badge is a visual representation of a microcredential, embedded with data that verifies a learner's skills and achievements. Badge criteria are developed with input from industry partners.

Before graduation

Retain access to your badges



Create a SkillStack® account

- If you haven't registered, go to the SkillStack® homepage (skillstack.idaho.gov) and select Register in the upper right corner of the page.
- You'll need your nine-digit state-issued student ID (EDUID). If you
 don't know it, ask your instructor.
- If you need help, watch the tutorial on the SkillStack® Learner page.



Log in to your account

- If you've already registered and created your account, go to the SkillStack® homepage.
- Forgot your password? Use the password reset link on the login page or watch the tutorial on the SkillStack[®] Learner page.



Update your email address

- Use a personal email address that you'll still have access to after graduation, not your school email.
- Employers may use SkillStack® to recruit you for job opportunities using this email address.
- If you're using a digital wallet to store your badges, be sure to use the same email for both the wallet and your SkillStack® account.

After graduation

Share the badges you've earned

Digital badges showcase your career-ready skills. They can support job applications, continuing education, or be used as evidence for college credit at Idaho institutions.

- Log in to SkillStack® (skillstack.idaho.gov) and go to the My Badges page.
- To share all your badges, copy the URL of your full portfolio.
- To share individual badges:
 - » Use the **colored tabs** on the left to choose a pathway and badge.
 - » Copy the badge's unique URL.

Once you've selected a badge, you can:

- Print a certificate that includes a QR code with verifiable badge data.
- Export the badge to access options for sharing it on your résumé, LinkedIn, and more.

Check for college credit opportunities

- Visit the Course Equivalencies page from the SkillStack® Learner site to see if your stacked badges are eligible for college credit at Idaho institutions.*
- Contact information for your Transition Coordinator is available on the SkillStack® Learner page. They can assist you with this process.
