

First Steps Standards Professional Development Course Overview

Welcome to Career Technical Education (CTE)! In accordance with <u>33-1614</u>, <u>Idaho Code</u>, this board-approved professional development course prepares Idaho teachers to deliver the First Steps Standards in required career exploration courses for seventh or eighth grade students.

The First Steps Standards Professional Development Course is a 15-hour, three-week course with three sequential modules delivered online through Canvas.

 - Module 2 Two pieces:
 - Unofficial transcript or certificate of completion of non-credit bearing Career Guidance/Development course
 - AND certificate of completion of professional development related to implicit bias
 - Module 3 Two pieces:
 - 21-22 or 22-23 course syllabus identifying the instruction of each of the First Steps Standards
 - AND submission of Parts 1 and 2 of the Capstone Project, as required

Documentation of Completion through SkillStack®

Progress toward and course completion is documented through Idaho's microcredential platform, SkillStack®. Sub-badges are awarded upon completion of each module and stack to a First Steps badge upon completion of the course. Participants will have access to their badges through SkillStack®.

Optional Professional Development Credit

One credit is available through the University of Idaho for \$60.00. One additional credit is available for submission of a reflective essay following the course for an additional \$60.00. More information will be shared in the course.
