- Finalizing CTE badges based on <u>revalidated standards</u> for year 25/26 are drafted and will be shared at CTE Connect conferences. 10 stacked badge sets.

- d. Who do we need on IMAC to be effective?
 - i. Need representation from registrars, chambers of commerce, career services, and trade associations.
 - ii. Consider rotating positions with standing roles for entities like Workforce Development and IDOC.
 - Suggestion to use regional rotation and alternate list to maintain diversity.
 - iv. Possibility of rotating topic-based attendance (e.g., corrections vs. postsecondary months).

 - 1. Well attended good feedback
 - 2. Panel notes from Heather
 - a. Heather is available for follow-up coordination with any of the national presenters.
 - ii. Feedback on IDCTE/IMAC facilitating a SkillStack® user meeting for each campus.
 - To encourage communication among badge approvers (starting with ISU)
- b. Industry Promotion
 - Reminder about Flyers/Folders -- IMAC can request to distribute to local employers.
 - 1. Employer folder insert
 - 2. Poster
 - ii. Added Idaho Dept of Parks and Recreation had to reject an employer from Colorado
 - iii. Had discussion with John Russ from CWI about Handshake will follow up to see about how best to display SkillStack® badges in that venue.

- iv. Attended Idaho Dental Association convention as an exhibitor handed out SkillStack® Recruit folders to potential employers.
 - 1. Good engagement. Sat a table with the dental assistant teacher at DTEC good to partner with teacher.
 - 2. Most conferences don't have HR folks there.
 - 3. Talked with a North Idaho dental network, front office staff that need workers, and vendors (banks mostly).
- c. Corrections Badging
 - i. Meeting with LCSC to discuss badging for corrections on July 1st.
 - ii. Had a brief meeting with ISU (Raelyn Price) to discuss. Will schedule a future meeting with ISU.
 - iii. Report of badges for corrections see slide below
 - 1. Report from April 2024 about Corrections badges issued.
 - 2. Between 2017-2022 there were 3700 badges awarded to 401 unique users. According to the records in SkillStack® there have been no digital badges issued after 2022. (Note this information is from a report run in 2024).
 - iv. Skill Stack Idaho Department of Corrections
 - v. What more do we want to know about Corrections badging?
 - vi. We can give a presentation about Corrections badging at next IMAC
 - vii. From Kimberly how are employers knowing about IDOC employees?
 - viii. Council to receive a full update/report in August
 - ix. Heather emphasized the importance of rekindling corrections partnerships; mentioned potential employers were once surveyed and trained to support residents earning credentials.
 - x. Rick shared anecdote of individual using SkillStack® badges to verify skills post-incarceration—highlighted power of digital badging for equity and documentation.
- d. Non-capstone teachers / students
 - i. Currently, only capstone teachers can issue badges; expanding access is under discussion.
 - ii. Meet with the IDCTE Program Quality Managers to discuss this.
 - 1. Current non-capstone badges
 - a. Financial Literacy
 - Feedback: Financial Literacy badge was too open-ended and caused confusion
 - b. Medical Terminology

- Feedback: Medical Terminology badge more successful due to targeted subject alignment
- c. Digital Literacy in the future.
- d. Brook Scoville shared that capstone teachers are duplicating work from lower levels; would benefit from having pathway teachers issue aligned badges earlier in student progress.
- iii. What does IMAC want to know to help move this discussion forward.
- iv. Next steps:
 - Possible pilot with clearly tiered programs (e.g., culinary, welding)
 - 2. Explore admin-level permission assignment or teacher opt-in forms
 - 3. Multiple rosters
 - 4. Council will revisit after feedback from Connect and further meetings with Program Quality Managers
