CTE Curricular Materials

The adoption process currently runs on a six (6) year adoption cycle. It is recommended that local school districts wait to purchase new curricular materials until after the main subject adoption year of the State Adoption Schedule & after effective contract date with the publishing companies. This ensures that schools purchase state approved materials at the contracted price.¹
