Boise Independent School District has been awarded federal grant funds as a subrecipient of the U.S. Department of Education's Career and Technical Education Basic Grants to States program as authorized under the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006, as amended by the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V). As a recipient of a Perkins Grant Subaward of FAIN 26E55EP000153, you agree to be bound by the requirements of the Grant Award Notification to the Idaho Division of Career Technical Education which are applicable to the subawards. To be eligible for Perkins V funds, subrecipients must offer at least one IDCTE approved program of study (pathway program), meet the administrative requirements in the [Perkins V Subrecipient Handbook](#), and submit a yearly Perkins V application based on results from a career technical education Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (CLNA). Perkins grant funds shall be used to improve and enhance CTE programs through projects. Projects should focus on activities that help meet CTE needs identified in your CLNA. Overall performance is measured by student outcomes.

Expenditure Period and Reimbursement

Funds are made available on a reimbursement basis subject to limitations of allowable uses and Division timelines for processing reimbursement requests. This award is for expenditures made within the state fiscal year of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027. Reimbursement claims must include project numbers as referenced in the tables below. Reimbursements must be requested using the process as directed by IDCTE. Reimbursement requests may be submitted as soon as the money has been spent at the local education agency/consortium/institution level. Completed requests must be submitted to perkins@cte.idaho.gov. Reimbursement requests must be submitted quarterly and no later than June 4, 2027. Reimbursement requests received after this date may be applied against the following year's award amounts if allowable and with prior approval from the Division. Prior state fiscal year expenditures cannot be reimbursed outside of the federal fiscal year for which the expenditure occurred.

Compliance Requirements

Perkins V compliance requirements are provided in the IDCTE [Perkins Subrecipient Handbook](#), acceptance of this award is acceptance of all the assurances identified in the Handbook.

The Federal awarding agency, Inspectors General, the Comptroller General of the United States, and the pass-through entity, or any of their authorized representatives, must have the right of access to any documents, papers or other records of the non-federal entity which are pertinent to the federal award, in order to make audits, examinations, excerpts, and transcripts. The right also includes timely and reasonable access to the non-federal entity's personnel for the purpose of interview and discussion related to such documents.

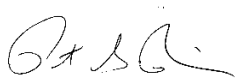
